- 1) We have graduate courses for general students and working students, *i.e.*, those working at hospitals, research or educational facilities, or companies.
- 2) For the convenience of working students, we hold classes and research guidance in the evenings, as well as on holidays and weekends.
- Applications for the working student course must be accompanied by a consent document issued from the applicant's current workplace.

2 Department Choice

- 1) Prior to applying, applicants must contact professors at the desired departments/laboratories.
- 2) Some fields may require a Japanese medical license or completion history of Japanese postgraduate training courses.

Application Conditions

Individuals who do not have Japanese citizenship, and who fulfil any of the criteria listed below by September 2023.

- 1) Individuals who completed or expect to complete 18 years of education in Japan or foreign countries, and possess a bachelor's degree from a medical, dental, 6-year course of veterinary, or 6-year course of pharmacy school.
- 2) Individuals who completed or expect to complete 18 years of education in Japan or foreign countries, and possess or expect to receive a master's degree.
- 3) Individuals who demonstrate ability comparable to or higher than those in 1) and 2).

Application Procedure

Applicants must complete the online registration process, submit application documents (by e-mail and submit the original by post or in person), and pay the examination fee.

1) Document submission:

- h. Photocopy of the wire transfer record
- i. Official documents to certify English examination scores
- Additional documents required for certain applicants:
- j. Document granting permission from the current workplace (designated form)

When submitting documents by post, be sure to use registered mail or an equivalent postal method. Documents that arrive after the deadline will not be accepted.

- 1) Any applicant whose current name does not match that on the diploma or any other documents is required to submit an official certification of the name change.
- 2) Applicants who need special arrangements due to any physical disabilities need to inform us when applying.
- 3) After application forms are submitted, they are not allowed to be changed.
- 4) The examination fee will not be refunded for any reason.
- 5) If false information is discovered in any application documents, admission and/or enrollment may be revoked at any time.

3) Examination fee

- a. The applicants should use a bank allowing foreign remittance (bank wire transfer) and transfer the examination fee of 20,000 Japanese yen into the following bank account.
- b. Please do not send US dollars or other currencies. In case you make payment in currencies other than Japanese yen, your application will not be accepted.
- c. Please note that you will have to bear all service charges/commissions for the bank transfer. There may be other bank transfer fees for correspondent banks (routing banks) as well (please confirm these fees when you make the transfer).
- d. Please note that you are responsible for all of these fees related to the cost of transfer. Thus, please make sure that you indicate to the remitting bank that you will bear all service charges/commission fees.
- e. Please make sure to submit the copy of the certificate of the remittance (receipt) issued by the bank, along with the other application documents.
- f. For the wire transfer, be sure to write the applicant's name (English alphabet) in the message column or any equivalent section.

7 Examination Subjects and Methods

- 1) Applicants are asked to have achieved scores described below or more within 5 years.
 - · TOEFL iBT, 63
 - IELTS, 5.5
 - TOEIC, 600
- 2) Skype Interview; for the interview appointment, contact professors at the desired departments/laboratories.

8 | Announcement of Examination Results

- 1) Successful application results will be posted between 3:00 pm on August 3 and 12:00pm on August 11, 2023, on the website.
- 2) Applicants may contact professors at the desired departments/laboratories for their results, but may not ask Graduate Student Affairs.

9 Enrollment Procedures

Each successful applicant will receive enrollment guidance upon notification of acceptance. Follow the directions of the guidance.

1 0 School Fees

Successful applicants must pay the total fee (below) by August 29th, 2023 (Tuesday).

- 1) The above fees will not be refunded for any reason.
- 2) Students who fall under 'a' or 'b' as noted below may receive a partial waiver (500,000 yen) of the 800,000 yen annual tuition for the doctoral course.
 - a. Students who are enrolled as general students.
 - b. Students who are enrolled as working students and belong to basic science departments /laboratories.

Note that students who receive the partial waiver but whose situation later changes are required to pay full tuition for the year. The full tuition will not be refunded.

- 3) Some international students may receive a full or partial waiver of school fees, living costs, and other costs from the Fujita Health University International Association Grant. Applicants who would like to apply for this grant need to consult professors at the desired department/laboratory.
- 4) Under the 2023 Grant-In-Aid from Fujita Health University "Global Education and Research Grant", the instructor who is planning to accept international graduate students hires them as research assistants for their international research project and submits the application. The subsidiary amount is 50,000 yen per person per month, and the number of acceptances is 2 students each year. Applicants who would like to apply for this grant need to consult professors at the desired department/laboratory.
- 5) Japanese government offers MEXT Scholarship for Embassy Recommendation and for University Recommendation. International students who wish to apply for the scholarship, please see the application guidelines on the MEXT website for more details.
