**1 Programs**

- 1) We have graduate courses for general students and working students.  
Note that general students are the students who study at university for four days or more in a week, and do not have any regular employment contracts with hospitals or companies.
- 2) For the convenience of working students, we hold classes and research guidance in the evenings, as well as on holidays and weekends.
- 3) Applications for the working student course must be accompanied by a consent document issued from the applicant's current workplace.

## 2 Department Choice

- 1) Prior to applying, applicants must contact supervisors at the desired departments/laboratories.
- 2) Some fields may require a Japanese medical license or completion history of Japanese postgraduate training courses.

### 3 Application Qualification

Individuals who do not have Japanese citizenship and fulfill any of the criteria listed below by September 2026:

- 1) Individuals who have completed or expect to complete 18 years of education in Japan or foreign countries, and possess a bachelor's degree from a medical, dental, 6-year course of veterinary, or 6-year course of pharmacy school.
- 2) Individuals who completed or expect to complete 18 years of education in Japan or foreign countries, and possess or expect to receive a master's degree.
- 3) Individuals who demonstrate ability comparable to or higher than those in 1) and 2).

### 5 Application Procedure

Applicants must complete the online registration process, submit application documents by e-mail, then submit the original documents by post or in person, and pay the examination fee.

#### 1) Application registration.

For requests to change any information after completing the online registration process, please contact the **Admissions Office**.
- Be sure to write down or print out your My Page login information (user ID and password).  
This login information will be required every time you access My Page.

#### 2) Document submission

The following mandatory documents and other additional documents must be sent by e-mail (data), then by post or in person (original).

Note that the certificates must be the original one with a wet signature or a seal of the organization.

<p><b>e. Certificate of academic transcripts</b></p> <p>1) Issued by a school that meets the application requirements.</p> <p>2) Original paper certificate.</p> <p>3) Identical to a. and d.</p> <p>4) These certificates must have been issued after April 2025.</p>
<p><b>f. Recommendation letters from 2 people</b></p> <p>1) Two letters of recommendation from individuals who can certify your identity, such as your former school in your home country. (Your academic supervisor at FHU does not qualify as a recommender.)</p> <p>2) Original documents bearing the recommender's signature.</p> <p>3) These letters must have been issued after April 2025.</p>
<p><b>g. Photocopy of applicant's passport (ID page)</b></p> <p>1) The information on the ID page must match that in a. (Name, date of birth)</p>
<p><b>h. Photocopy of wire transfer record of Examination fee</b></p> <p>1) The application fee amount (20,000 yen) must be correct.</p> <p>2) If you wish to remit the application fee from within Japan, please request information for the domestic bank account, as the application guidelines list an overseas remittance account.</p>
<p><b>i. Official score report of English examination</b></p> <p>1) Those meeting the required scores: TOEFL iBT 63, IELTS 5.5, TOEIC (L&amp;R) 600</p> <p>2) Those matching the scores listed in a.</p> <p>3) Original paper certificates.</p> <p>4) Digital certificates are acceptable only for TOEIC.</p> <p>5) Certificates issued within 5 years of the application date.</p>

j. Pre-screening sheet for accepting foreigners(Designated form)
1) The sheet will be submitted <b>by the supervisor</b> in accordance with the FHU Security Export Control Regulations.
k. Application Form for Tuition Fee Reduction System (Designated form)
1)Applicants of the Tuition Fee Reduction System must be qualified for both of the below requirements. 1. To study for four days or more in a week as a general student, engage to research under being supervised by professor. 2. Not to have any regular employment contracts with hospitals or companies etc. 2) Do not to forget to sign your name or stamp your seal on the ㊦ mark. 3) Note that your application may not be accepted if you do not pass the eligibility screening after submitting the application form. Only successful applicants are eligible for a tuition reduction of 200,000 yen from the standard 500,000 yen tuition fee upon admission.

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When sending documents by post, be sure to use registered mail or an equivalent postal method. Documents received after the deadline will not be accepted.

- Applicants whose current name do not match those on the certificate, or any other documents, are required to submit an official certification of the name change.
- If the certificates are not in English or Japanese, applicants must submit both the originals and translations by an accredited translator.
- Applicants who need special arrangements due to any physical disabilities need to inform us when applying.
- After application forms are submitted, they are not allowed to be changed.
- The examination fee will not be refunded for any reason.
- If false information is discovered in any application documents, admission and/or enrollment may be revoked at any time.

### 3) Payment of Examination fee

The applicants should use a bank allowing foreign remittance (bank wire transfer) and transfer the examination fee of 20,000 Japanese yen into the following bank account.

- a. The applicants who have graduated or expect to graduate from the master's course at Fujita

Health University do not need to pay the examination fee.

- b. Please do not send US dollars or other currencies. In case you make payment in currencies other than Japanese yen, your application will not be accepted.
- c. Please note that you will have to bear all service charges/commissions for the bank transfer. There may be other bank transfer fees for corresponding banks (routing banks) as well. Please confirm these fees when you make the transfer.
- d. Please note that you are responsible for all of these fees related to the cost of transfer. Thus, please make sure that you indicate to the remitting bank that you will bear all service charges/commission fees.
- e. Please make sure to submit the copy of the certificate of remittance (receipt) issued by the bank, along with the other application documents.
- f. For the wire transfer, be sure to write the applicant's name (English alphabet) in the message column or any equivalent section.

## **6 Examination**

- 1) Examination period: Monday, July 6, 2026 – Friday, July 10, 2026
- 2) Contents of examination: Online interview
- 3) Details will be notified to the applicants whose application documents are successfully accepted.

## **7 Announcement of Examination Results**

- 1) Successful application results will be posted between 3:00 pm on July 31 and 12:00pm on

August 7, 2026, on the website.

- 2) Applicants may contact supervisors at the desired departments/laboratories for their results, but may not ask Graduate Student Affairs.

## **8** Enrollment Procedures

Each successful applicant will receive enrollment guidelines upon notification of acceptance. Follow the directions of the guidelines.

## **9** School Fees

**Successful applicants must pay the total fee (below) by August 26, 2026.**

- 1) The above fees will not be refunded for any reason. However, if the applicant submits a notice of withdrawal from enrollment (optional format) by 17:00 Monday, on August 31, 2026 (must arrive) and requests a refund of the payment of the school fee, it will be refunded, excluding the enrollment fee.
- 2) Successful applicants of general students who are eligible for a tuition reduction may receive a partial waiver (200,000 yen) of the 500,000 yen annual tuition for the doctoral course. Applicants of the Tuition Fee Reduction System must submit the Application Form for Tuition Fee Reduction System in the application period.  
  
Note that general students are the students who study at university for, in principle, four days or more in a week, and do not have any regular employment contracts with hospitals or companies. When a general student's situation changes to a working one at the beginning or middle of the school year, University will ask for the full tuition fee.

### 3) Scholarship Information

#### Fujita Academy Grant

The Fujita Academy Grant is provided to prospective international students facing financial challenges that are hindering their studies at Fujita Health University. Recipients, who show exceptional motivation, are not required to repay the grant. Interested students should contact their accepting supervisors to apply for the grant.
